



Tender Years Cooperative Preschool Enrollment Agreement

I hereby make the application to have _____, a child of _____ years of age, attend the Tender Years Cooperative Preschool for the school term from September 2008 to May 2009.

I am the parent or guardian of the child. (please circle one)

If the above named child is admitted by the preschool, I agree to pay the registration fee and May's tuition* to be sent with this Enrollment Agreement and the tuition as stated below.

_____ Three year old/two day session \$540 per year or \$60 per month
+ \$50 registration fee (non-refundable)

_____ Four year old/three day session \$810 per year or \$90 per month
+ \$50 registration fee (non-refundable)

*May's tuition is required at the time of registration. The exception is anyone currently enrolled in the school. These members have until orientation in August to pay May's tuition. May's tuition will be refunded if the school is notified that a student will not be attending. Tuition is subject to change due to budget increases.

A one time \$20 supply fee will be due with September's tuition.

It is agreed that I shall not be relieved of my obligations to make payments herein agreed to, and that no deduction or allowance from any of the said payments shall be made by reason of the absence or withdrawal of said pupil except by petition in writing of the board. Nor shall there be a deduction for any cancellation of class due to snow or emergency days. Every effort will be made to make up a reasonable number of snow days. It is understood that the preschool reserves the right, for any cause that the officers of the said preschool may consider sufficient, to suspend or dismiss the child.

The preschool regulations, as stated in the handbook, not at variance with any of the provisions herein, are to be considered as, and made a part of, this agreement. This is a legal and binding contract.
